## **Third Quarter Report Highlights**

### **Crime Trends:**

- July 2011- Two unrelated Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance arrests were made.
- July 2011 - a number of vehicle larcenies and home burglaries were reported. Suspects were eventually arrested and charged with these crimes.
- August 2011 – Eric Zona of Rochester, N.Y. was arrested for Disorderly Conduct. Zona was very combative with police and was also charged with Resisting Arrest and Obstructing Governmental Administration. While being transported to the police department Zona kicked the rear window of the police car causing damage to it. Zona was also charged with Criminal Mischief and remanded to Monroe County Jail.
- August 2011 – Five separate arsons were committed in the village within a two hour period of time. Within two days of these crimes Phillip Ziegler and Adam Bond were both charged with the arsons.
- September 2011 – A report of an attempted abduction was reported to the Brockport Police Department. To date nobody has been identified as a suspect relative to this incident.
- I have attached all Media Release sheets relative to crimes that have occurred in the Village of Brockport and provided to the media on a weekly basis by Sergeant Mark Philippy during this past quarter.

### **Miscellaneous**

- Synopsis: During this quarter the Brockport Police Department, handled 3,750 calls for service, made 77 criminal and violation arrests, 12 DWI arrests, took 25 criminal mischief reports, 25 family trouble reports, 6 burglary reports, 9 grand larceny reports, and a number of other reports. In addition Brockport Police made 382 Vehicle and Traffic arrests that included 70 speeding tickets, 18 aggravated unlicensed operation tickets, 12 un-inspected motor vehicle tickets, 440 parking tickets, 153 village ordinance arrests and took 24 Motor Vehicle Accidents.

The fires were set between midnight and 2:30 a.m. and involved a dumpster on Willowbrooke Drive, parked cars on Gordon and Spring streets, a trash can in an alley off Queen Street and a barn at Perry and Holley streets. No injuries were reported. The barn was heavily damaged by the fire, which was extinguished by Brockport firefighters. In both cases involving cars, something was lighted and stuffed into the gas tanks, but the tanks did not ignite. It is believed that it was their intent to ignite the cars and for the cars to explode and ignite the nearby occupied houses. Shortly after fires were reported, Bond was stopped by Monroe County sheriff's deputies while walking on a road in Clarkson, Varrenti said. Deputies questioned him and found that he was wanted on a burglary charge in Genesee County. He was turned over to the Genesee County Jail. Ziegler was taken into custody about 3 a.m. Wednesday by Rochester Police. Ziegler was arraigned in Sweden Town Court and was remanded to the Monroe County Jail. Bond remained in the Genesee County Jail on Wednesday. Both males are being held in lieu of \$5,000 cash bail or \$10,000 bond. Additional charges are pending. The investigation continues. Virtually every member of the BPD contributed to the excellent investigatory work, which helped lead to a quick arrest in this incident.
