In addition Brockport Police made 280 Vehicle and Traffic arrests that included 52 speeding tickets, 14 aggravated unlicensed operation tickets, 51 un-inspected motor vehicle tickets, 465 parking tickets and took 30 Motor Vehicle Accidents.
