In addition Brockport Police made 507 Vehicle and Traffic arrests that included 68 speeding tickets, 14 aggravated unlicensed operation tickets, 47 un-inspected motor vehicle tickets, 378 parking tickets, 63 village ordinance arrests and took 31 Motor Vehicle Accidents.
